SHOW RULES

Entry Fees- \$8 per head per ring. POSTMARKED by MAY 20, 2018. Entry fee for exhibitors pre-entering 10 or more animals will be \$6, animals must be from same owner. Entry fees must be enclosed with entry form. Late entries (postmarked after May 20, 2018) or entries received without money will be \$10 per head with no discount. Late entries will be accepted until 7:30am the day of the show.

This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association (all sanctioned breeds) and their rules shall govern. The Senior and Junior open shows are separately sanctioned for Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerian Dwarfs, Nubians, Saanens, AOPs and Recorded Grades. Both Senior and Junior doe shows will be held in Rings 1 and 2. Registration/Recordation certificates are required for all animals six months of age or older. No copies allowed. A stamped duplicate or faxed application (from the ADGA office) will be accepted for animals under six months of age. Certificate papers must be presented to the Show Secretary before judging shall begin (ADGA rule X1-A-6). *Champion Challenge entries:* Proof of Championship is

required and shall be either: (1) The prefix CH, GCH or SGCH as affixed by ADGA on the animal's registration or recordation certificate; or (2) Presentation of the Permanent Champion Certificate Notification Letter issued by ADGA in conjunction with the original registration or recordation certificate. The letter is valid for use until December 31st of the year of issuance.

Animals must be in place no later than 7:30 am the day of the show.

One-Day Milk Test - Does participating in the one-day milk test must be in place by 6:30 pm on Friday, May 25, 2018. Does participating in this will be milked under the watchful eye of the tester at 7 pm on Friday, 7 am on Saturday, and 7 pm on Saturday. Milk weights will be recorded for all three milkings, and sampled for the second and third milking. Fee for the one-day test is \$7.00 per doe and should be paid prior to the first milk out. Please use the entry form to provide required information for each doe.

BASE DATE FOR SHOW: MAY 26, 2018 NO MILK OUT

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All animals must be free of draining abscesses, pink eye, ringworm, external parasites and sore mouth. If the animal is questionable, please leave it at home.

SUBSTITUTIONS – within the same breed will be allowed. These animals must be entered with the Show Secretary prior to the beginning of the show.

Junior and Senior Best of Breed winners must be exhibited in the “Best in Show” class. If you leave before this class is held, you will forfeit the Championship leg earned at this show (ADGA rule X1-J-9).

There will be Champion Challenge classes for Senior Does in all sanctioned breeds in both rings. The entry fee will be the same as other classes. The prefix CH, GCH or SGCH as affixed by ADGA *must* be on the animal's registration/recordation certificate, OR presentation of the notification letter, issued by ADGA, in conjunction with the original registration/recordation certificate. THE LETTER IS VALID FOR USE UNTIL DECEMBER 31 OF THE YEAR OF ISSUANCE, after which the certificate of registration/recordation must be officially updated.

Champions, Reserve Champions, Best of Breed and Best Doe/Best Junior Doe in Show winners – please take a moment to carefully review the information on the Official Report of Awards prior to signing it. Our Show Secretaries and Show Chair strive to complete these forms correctly, but mistakes do happen and we don't want you to forfeit a leg on your animal due to an inadvertent error.

Embedded Youth Show Entries: Animals must be registered in child's name only, not the family. Entries are \$2.00 per class, and the animal must be entered in the Open Show Ring 1 as well, since it is an embedded show. Late entries will remain \$2. Total entry fee will be \$10 (\$2 youth + \$8 open); this does not include entering the Ring 2 open show. Exhibitors may enter multiple does in a class as long as they are handled by another youth exhibitor. The Memorial Lucille Garner Supreme Youth Showmanship Award (Banner and \$50) will be awarded to the youth who wins the Embedded Youth Show Senior Doe Championship with their doe. The Embedded Youth Show Junior Doe Champion will be awarded a rosette and \$25.

Showmanship will take place between the Senior and Junior Doe Shows. There is no fee for Showmanship classes. Showmanship is open to all youth exhibitors regardless of whose name the animal is registered.

Open Shows Prize Monies - \$100 will be awarded to the Best Doe in Show in Rings 1 and 2, and \$50 will be awarded to the Best Junior Doe in Show in Rings 1 and 2.

Please bring extra handlers, open shows will be run simultaneously.

Hay may be fed in the barn, preferably in containers.

Overudderred does may be discriminated against by the judges. If you need to relieve your doe of excess milk, please do so into a pail and not on the ground. If your doe leaks milk onto the concrete, please clean up after her. Please be considerate of other exhibitors and their animals. Do not leave animals for extended periods of time in the holding pens that have no bedding in them.

There will be a \$4 per pen non-refundable fee, charged by the fairgrounds for cleaning the facility after the show is over with.

The show barn will be open at 4 pm on Friday, May 25, 2018, for early arrivals. The registration table will be open from 6-9 pm on Friday and 6:30-8:00 am on Saturday.

EARLY ENTRIES ARE ENCOURAGED SO WE CAN TRY TO MAKE EACH BREED OFFICAL.

The SCTGC and the Washington County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for any losses or damages incurred by exhibitors or visitors; all animals will be shown at owners' risk. Parents will be held responsible for the actions of their children. Exhibitors are requested to be neatly and appropriately attired, preferably in white; however, dark pants/skirt and white shirt are acceptable.

We are instituting a "NO ALCOHOL" policy this year. Please do not bring beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages onto the show grounds. Please consider our youth and set a good example for them. Anyone who is found with alcoholic beverages in their possession will be asked to relinquish them (they will be returned when you leave the showgrounds at the end of the day on Saturday).

Receipt of entry will be an agreement by the exhibitor to abide by the show rules. Make sure your does are tattooed and that their tattoos match their registration papers. We do have a microchip reader available for those animals that may have faded or illegible tattoos and are also microchipped; however, the microchip number must be listed on the animal's registration papers and it must match the microchip that is being read.

ADGA ONE-DAY MILK TEST RULES

Tester/Supervisor – Caroline Lawson

1. ADGA general rules apply to the milk test.*
2. This one-day milk test is for any doe registered or recorded with ADGA, AGS or CGS. Registration certificate must be shown to the supervisor and tattoo read at this time. Fee is \$7.00 per doe. Accurate kidding date must be supplied.
3. Preliminary milking and checking of the does is at 7:00 PM on Friday, May 25, 2018. Does on verification test must be milked while supervised at this time. Bring verification forms with you.
4. All the does are to be milked, milk weighed and samples taken at 7:00 AM. and 7:00 PM on Saturday, while supervised.

Entry fees for the one-day milk test should be mailed with show entries or paid at time of check in. Please be sure to include information for does participating in the one-day milk test on the regular entry form.
